Long-term medication in veterinary practice refers to drugs prescribed for **ongoing, chronic, or lifelong conditions** that require continuous management rather than a short-term cure.

Long-term Condition	Medication
Arthritis	Loxicom (<i>size 15ml+</i>), Previcox, Onsior, Galliprant, Librela, Solensia
Epilepsy	Pexion, Libromide/Vetbromide/Epilease, Soliphen, Epiphen (Solution only)
Heart Disease	Cardisure, Cardalis, Libeo/ Frusemide/Frusol, Prilactone, Upcard, Fortekor/Benefortin/Benazecare, Clopidogrel
Skin Conditions	Apoquel, Zenrelia, Atopica, Cytopoint
Urinary Incontinence (dogs)	Incurin, Propalin
High Blood Pressure	Amodip
Kidney Disease	Semintra, Fortekor/Benefortin/Benazecare
Dry Eye (in dogs)	Optimmune
Diabetes	Caninsulin, ProZinc
Thyroid Disorders	Thyforon, Thyronorm
Adrenal Disorders	Zycortal, Vetoryl
Cognitive Dysfunction	Vivitonin, Vitofyllin
